STEPS TO BRAINVIEW

STEP 01

Brainview Education and Scheduling

Your Salience Health Provider may have recommended that you learn about Brainview as part of your new patient intake. A Salience Health Care Navigator will guide you through this educational process, along with any other necessary information. After the education session, you'll have the option to schedule your Brainview test. If you have questions about costs and insurance coverage, our team can assist you. You can pay when scheduling your appointment or on the day of testing.

STEP 02

Day of Testing

On the day of the test, please avoid stimulants, but you can take your regular prescription medication. Ensure clean, dry hair and wear comfy clothing. Minimize caffeine and aim for a good night's sleep. You can drive normally as the only residue will be water-soluble gel used during setup.

Upon arrival, a technician will guide you to a testing room. You'll fill out some questionnaires while the technician prepares. They'll place a cap with electrodes on your head, applying harmless saline gel. EKG leads and a pulse oximeter will also be placed to observe your brain's and heart's natural signals.



STEP 03

The Assessment and Results

Once set up, the test takes about 25 minutes. It includes five minutes of observing your brain with open eyes, five minutes with closed eyes, and a 12 minute reaction time test. Afterward, the technician removes the cap and provides a gel cleaner.

You can schedule a follow-up appointment if needed. Your results will be ready at your next appointment with your provider. These results are for your provider's assessment, but you can request a copy. Remember, your provider's guidance is crucial for interpreting the results and planning your treatment.
